In 2000 she progressed to a career in the medical device industry where she began to take a keen interest in the application of wound management products and their role in the animal patient in 2005. Fueled by a lack of up to date, independent education on wound dressings for vets she dedicated herself to bringing modern wound technologies to the veterinary patient through consultancy and education. Georgie has since become a council member and Secretary (2007-2013) of the Veterinary Wound Healing Association, and now presents internationally on the subject of wound healing and the role of dressings. Most recently Georgie has presented workshops at NAVC (2013) and SEVC (2012) and has frequently lectured on behalf of BSAVA, BEVA and BVNA.

Georgie is a member of EWMA (European Wound Management Association) and an honorary member of CITER (Cardiff Institute of Tissue Engineering and Repair) and is proud to be an associate member of the BVNA.
