

CONDITIONS OF REGISTERING FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR OF STUDY 2011/2012

Study programme: General Veterinary Medicine (GVM)

1. Registering of students for the 2nd year of study- Study programme GVM

- a) Registering of students for the 2nd year of study – is conditional upon earning the minimum number of credits required by the study plan (47 credits). Credits earned for compulsory optional subject are excluded from the minimum required credits.
- b) The repeated registration for the 1st year – requires the minimum number of credits – 24 credits (the credits earned in successfully passed examinations for compulsory optional subjects are included into account of the minimum number of credits).
- c) The repeated registration of a study subject for the 2nd year - is possible only for the compulsory optional subjects (Zoology, Basic of ecology and Slovak language), and only if a student had earned all credits for obligatory subjects.

2. Registering of students for the 3rd year of study- Study programme GVM

- a) Registering of students for the 3rd year of study – is conditional upon earning the minimum number of credits required by the study plan (61 credits). Credits earned for compulsory optional subject are excluded from the minimum required credits.
- b) The repeated registration for the 2nd year – requires the minimum number of credits – 31 credits (the credits earned in successfully passed examinations for compulsory optional subjects are included into account of the minimum number of credits).
- c) The repeated registration of a study subject for the 3rd year - is possible only for the compulsory optional subject (Radiobiology, Radiographic anatomy), and only if a student earned all credits for obligatory subjects.

3. Registering of students for the 4th year of study- Study programme GVM

- a) Registering of students for the 4th year of study – is conditional upon earning the minimum number of credits required by the study plan (54 credits). Credits earned for compulsory optional subject are excluded from the minimum required credits.
- b) The repeated registration for the 3rd year – requires the minimum number of credits – 28 credits (the credits earned in successfully passed examinations for compulsory optional subjects are included into account of the minimum number of credits).
- c) The repeated registration of a study subject for the 4th year - is possible only for the compulsory optional subject (Basics of veterinary haematology, Applied

virology and Molecular mechanisms of metabolic and inherent diseases), and only if a student earned all credits for obligatory subjects.

4. Registering of students for the 5th year of study- Study programme GVM

- d) Registering of students for the 5th year of study – is conditional upon earning the minimum number of credits required by the study plan (54 credits). Credits earned for compulsory optional subject are excluded from the minimum required credits.
- e) The repeated registration for the 4th year – requires the minimum number of credits – 28 credits (the credits earned in successfully passed examinations for compulsory optional subjects are included into account of the minimum number of credits).
- f) The repeated registration of a study subject for the 4th year - is possible only for the compulsory optional subject (Applied cytology, Clinical biochemistry, Basics of horse shoeing, Clinical microbiology and immunology), and only if a student earned all credits for obligatory subjects.

5. Registering of students for the 4th BSc. year of study- Post bachelor study programme GVM

- a) Registering of students for the 4th BSc. year of study – is conditional upon earning the minimum number of credits required by the study plan (52 credits). Credits earned for compulsory optional subject are excluded from the minimum required credits.
- b) The repeated registration for the 3rd BSc. year – requires the minimum number of credits – 27 credits (the credits earned in successfully passed examinations for compulsory optional subjects are included into account of the minimum number of credits).
- c) The repeated registration of a study subject for the 4th BSc. year - is possible only for the compulsory optional subjects (Slovak language and Statistics and basic of computing technique), and only if a student had earned all credits for obligatory subjects.

6. Registering of students for the 5th BSc. year of study- Post bachelor study programme GVM

- a) Registering of students for the 5th BSc. year of study – is conditional upon earning the minimum number of credits required by the study plan (68 credits). Credits earned for compulsory optional subject are excluded from the minimum required credits.
- b) The repeated registration for the 4th BSc. year – requires the minimum number of credits – 35 credits (the credits earned in successfully passed examinations for compulsory optional subjects are included into account of the minimum number of credits).
- c) The repeated registration of a study subject for the 5th BSc. year - is possible only for the compulsory optional subjects (Breeding and diseases of reptiles and terrarial animals and Applied virology), and only if a student had earned all credits for obligatory subjects.

7. Registering of students for the 6th post bachelor - Study programme

- a) Registering of students for the 6th BSc. year of study – is conditional upon earning the minimum number of credits required by the study plan (47 credits). Credits earned for compulsory optional subject are excluded from the minimum required credits.
- b) The repeated registration for the 5th BSc. year – requires the minimum number of credits – 24 credits (the credits earned in successfully passed examinations for compulsory optional subjects are included into account of the minimum number of credits).
- c) The repeated registration of a study subject for the 6th BSc. year - is possible only for the compulsory optional subjects (Cardio-respiratory diseases of small animals and Clinical microbiology and immunology), and only if a student had earned all credits for obligatory subjects.
