**Criteria for awarding points for assessing entitlement to accommodation
at Student Dormitories
of the University of Veterinary Medicine and Pharmacy in Košice
valid from academic year 2020/2021**

- 1) Every student expresses his/her interest in accommodation at the Student Dormitories of the University of Veterinary Medicine and Pharmacy in Košice (hereinafter referred to as the “UVMP”) by submitting an application for accommodation in the UVMP Academic Information System (hereinafter referred to as the “AIS”).
- 2) A student, who had accommodation provided in the previous academic year at contractual Student Dormitories of another university or who is interested in accommodation in contractual Student Dormitories of another university, is also obliged to submit an application in the AIS.
- 3) The deadline for submission of an application for accommodation is published in the AIS at the beginning of the spring semester which precedes the academic year for which the application for accommodation is submitted.
- 4) Applications are assessed according to the criteria set out below, by the sum of the points set out below:

a) Distance from the place of residence:

61 – 120 km	30 points
121 – 180 km	45 points
181 – 240 km	60 points
241 – 300 km	75 points
301 and more km	90 points

b) Student’s achievement in the last completed year of study – weighted study average according to data in the AIS (except for students who, in the academic year for which they are applying the accommodation for, continue into the second year of study):

1.00 – 1.2	90 points
1.21 – 1.5	75 points
1.51 – 2.0	45 points
2.01 and more	0 points

c) Students continuing into the second year of study in the following academic year
45 points

(at the time of submission of applications for accommodation, the examination period necessary for calculation of the weighted study average is not yet completed)

d) Student:

- Holder of a disability card 50 points
(disability card must be delivered to the Accommodation Department of the Student Dormitories of the UVMP in Košice during the period of the submission of the application for accommodation)
- Registered in the Evidence of students with specific needs 40 points
(decision on registration in the Evidence of students with specific needs must be delivered to the Accommodation Department of the Student Dormitories of the UVMP in Košice during the period of the submission of the application for accommodation)
- Receiving a social scholarship 40 points
- Receiving a motivational scholarship 20 points
- Active member of special interest clubs 20 points
(on the proposal of the club chairman, approved by the club guarantor)
- Member of the university Board of Trustees, member of the university Student Chamber 20 points

Of all the above options, two will be accepted (with the highest number of points).

- 5) Students admitted to the first year of study may apply for accommodation if they have a permanent residence of 61 km or more from Košice and apply for accommodation no later than July 31st of the relevant year. For admitted students, 300 places of the accommodation capacity of the Student Dormitories are reserved, which will be allocated on the basis of an assessment of the distance from the place of permanent residence, as specified in par 4a).
- 6) The list of students will be created on the basis of obtained points and accommodation will be allocated on the basis of these points.
- 7) Students of the final year of General Veterinary Medicine study programme (including post BSc.) with the permanent residence of 61 km and more from Košice are entitled to accommodation.
- 8) Students – members of the UVMP Academic Senate and Chairmen of UVMP special interest clubs, with the exception of permanent residence in Košice, are entitled to accommodation.
- 9) In case of violation of the Dormitory Rules of Student Dormitories of the UVMP, 50 points are deducted from the total number of points obtained by the student.
- 10) If student grossly violates the Dormitory Rules of Student Dormitories of the UVMP, the Accommodation Committee will proceed according to the Dormitory Rules based on the proposal of the Director of Student Dormitories.
- 11) Only application completed in the AIS is included in the list of applications for accommodation.
- 12) Student loses the right to accommodation for the requested academic year in case of providing incorrect and misleading information in any of these criteria.
- 13) Accommodation in Student Dormitories of the contractual partner – Technical University of Košice (hereinafter referred to as “TUKE”):

Students applying for accommodation at TUKE Student Dormitories are obliged to submit the application for accommodation in the UVMP AIS and write TUKE in the “Application note” field.

Students who do not apply for accommodation in the UVMP AIS system lose their right to accommodation in the Student Dormitories of the UVMP and their contractual partner TUKE. The results will be evaluated according to the relevant criteria. The Accommodation Committee decides on the allocation of the accommodation facility. The application for accommodation must contain only one accommodation facility.

Criteria for awarding points for assessing entitlement to accommodation at Student Dormitories of the University of Veterinary Medicine and Pharmacy in Košice dated December 8th 2016, approved by the Academic Senate of the UVMP in Košice on December 8th 2016, are cancelled.

Criteria for awarding points for assessing entitlement to accommodation at Student Dormitories of the University of Veterinary Medicine and Pharmacy in Košice shall enter into force on the day of approval by the Academic Senate of the UVMP in Košice.
