ADDENDUM No. 1

**to the Dormitory Rules
of the University of Veterinary Medicine and Pharmacy in Košice**



The purpose of this Addendum No. 1 to the Dormitory Rules of the University of Veterinary Medicine and Pharmacy in Košice, dated November 19, 2024, is to regulate the prohibition of bringing weapons into the student dormitory buildings in order to ensure safety and a peaceful environment within the dormitories.

1. Article 8, paragraph 3, letter o) reads:

"o) to bring and possess weapons in the SD (students who are authorized holders of firearms based on a gun license – e.g., group D for hunting purposes, group E for sporting purposes, etc., are required to store their weapons in the safe located at the reception of SD 2 and must comply with the Rector's Directive dated June 18, 2012, which regulates the storage and handling of hunting weapons and ammunition stored in the safe at SD 2); details regarding the prohibition of bringing weapons are outlined in Appendix No. 5 to the Dormitory Rules."

2. Appendix No. 5 to the Dormitory Rules of the University of Veterinary Medicine and Pharmacy in Košice – Prohibition of Bringing Weapons is supplemented as follows:

"Prohibition of Bringing Weapons"

1. Introductory Provision

This appendix regulates the prohibition of bringing weapons into the student dormitory buildings in order to ensure safety and a peaceful environment for all resident students and staff of the student dormitories.

2. Definition of a Weapon

For the purposes of these dormitory rules, a weapon is considered to be any object that is designed or potentially usable to cause injury or damage, particularly including the following:

a) Firearms:

- All types of firearms (e.g., pistols, revolvers, rifles, shotguns), including their replicas and imitations
- Air guns (e.g., air rifles, air pistols)
- Gas weapons (e.g., tear gas pistols, gas revolvers)
- Paintball and airsoft guns
- Bows and crossbows
- Rubber bullet guns

b) Stabbing and cutting weapons:

- Knives (excluding kitchen knives with a blade length up to 15 cm)
- Daggers, axes, swords, sabre, machetes, etc.
- Bayonets, throwing stars

c) Explosives and pyrotechnic products:

- Firecrackers, Roman candles, and other pyrotechnic products
- Explosives and improvised explosive devices

d) Blunt weapons:

- Baseball bats and softball bats
- Two-handed clubs, truncheons, etc.



- Martial arts weapons
 - Brass knuckles
- e) Other weapons, tools, and dangerous items:
- Narcotic and irritating substances
 - Electric stun guns, tasers, stun batons, etc.
 - Saws, drills, hammers, etc.
 - Other items that are modified or intended for use as a weapon (e.g., improvised weapons, etc.)
3. Exceptions
- Kitchen knives with a blade length of up to 15 cm are allowed for use in kitchen areas.
 - Students who are authorized holders of firearms based on a gun license – e.g., group D for hunting purposes, group E for sporting purposes, etc., are required to store their weapons in the safe located at the reception of SD 2 and must comply with the Rector's Directive dated June 18, 2012, which regulates the storage and handling of hunting weapons and ammunition stored in the safe at SD 2.
4. Responsibility and Sanctions
- In the event of a violation of this prohibition, the student will be subject to disciplinary sanctions in accordance with the Dormitory Rules of the UVLF.
 - In case of suspicion of a criminal offense, the director of the SD will inform the relevant authorities involved in criminal proceedings.
3. Other provisions of the Dormitory Rules dated November 19, 2024, remain in effect.
4. This Addendum No. 1 to the Dormitory Rules of the University of Veterinary Medicine and Pharmacy in Košice, dated November 19, 2024, enters into force and effect on the day of its signing.
